Project outline

The Social Investment Intelligence Network is a group of UK social entrepreneurs meeting on a quarterly basis, in a variety of locations across the UK, to review demand for social investment amongst social enterprises, charities and other organisations with a social purpose.

The Network will be comprised of 10-12 social entrepreneurs from around the UK with knowledge of and interest in the development of the social investment market, and awareness of new developments in their local areas and professional sectors.

Desirable qualities

- An understanding of how social investment is being used and the initiatives/funds available in a particular sector or geographic region. Alternatively, a broader perspective and experience of the social investment market would be useful.
- An understanding of different situations where social investment could be useful where it is not currently available.

Responsibilities:

- Attend a total of four quarterly meetings during the one-year pilot programme
- To read brief meeting preparation resources and be willing to engage in discussions during the meetings
